## **Grape Tomatoes**

Our grape tomato hybrids are bred for tropical greenhouse conditions, offering high yields and excellent fruit quality. The fruits are firm, sweet, and flavorful—perfect for salads, snacking, and colorful mixed packs. With medium resistance to TYLCV, these varieties are a reliable choice for commercial growers.

Pink, grape tomato, fruit weight 12-15 g.

Bright Yellow, grape tomato, fruit weight 15-17 g.

Green, grape tomato, fruit weight 12-15 g.



#### Pastichio F1

Green with dark shoulder, grape tomato, fruit weight 12-15 g.



#### Colada F1

Brown, grape tomato, fruit weight 15-17 g.



## **Snack Cucumbers**

#### Nana F1



Nana F1 produces medium-green fruits, 8–10 cm long and weighing 40–45 grams. The fruits have a delicious flavor and a crisp texture. This vigorous, parthenocarpic variety develops multiple female flowers per node, resulting in high yields. It adapts well to various growing conditions, with harvest beginning 30–35 days after sowing. Ideal for both home gardening and professional cultivation.

#### **CX 104 F1**



CX104 F1 produce dark-green fruits, 12–13 cm in length, weighing 70-75 grams. It is a high-performing parthenocarpic type, yielding 1–3 fruits per node and is well adapted for summer, and autumn cultivation. With very early maturity, it can be harvested just 30 days after sowing. Ideal for both home gardening and professional growers, it offers excellent yield potential.







## **Blocky Sweet Pepper**

#### **Green Block Hunter F1**

Fruits are slowly maturing and suitable for green harvesting. Grows well all year round, with good cold tolerance and reliable fruit setting. Resistance: TmO-2





#### Red Block TP1031 F1

Early variety with nice fruit shape. Fruits 200 gram.

Resistances: TmO-3, TSWV

#### Yellow Block TP2010 F1

Strong and healthy crop. Short plant type. Fruits 200 grams with thick walls. Resistances: TmO-3





## **Sweet Bites**



Hybrid Sweet Bite pepper varieties specially bred for indoor cultivation in cooler, high-altitude areas, these pepper varieties produce small, 30–45 g./fruits with a crispy, sweet and excellent yield. Each vibrant color—red, yellow, orange, purple, and olive green and brown—represents a unique variety.

Not suitable for hot climates, as high temperatures can reduce performance.

## **Tabasco Hot Pepper**

#### **PX-902**

Tabasco PX-902 combines intense pungency, with good flavor and excellent yield. The tall, vigorous plants grow up to 1.7 meters and start fruit harvesting in 60–70 days. Their height allows for easy fruit picking of the pendant fruits. Grown on large scale in Thailand, Indonesia, the Philippines, and Mexico.









## **Thai Hot Pepper**



**Thai hot pepper hybrids** have a distinct aroma, high pungency, uniform fruit size, consistent high yields, and vigorous plant growth. Suitable for fresh use or drying.

Our hybrids are actively progressing through our breeding pipeline.



Fruit size: 7-9 cm

Fruit weight: 3.5 - 4.5 gram per fruit

Peduncle lenght\*: 3.5-4.5 cm

\*The long peduncle lenght support shelflife, ensuring postharvest quality during storage and transport.









We are currently evaluating two test hybrids of the Japanese type with greenhouse growers. The varieties are completely female flowering and parthenocarpic.
